With regular travel across Victoria, this purposeful role focuses on growing our fresh produce category, ensuring a consistent supply of fruit and vegetables. You'll build strong relationships with farmers, wholesalers, and donors to source nutritious produce that supports vulnerable communities. The position offers flexibility to be based at one of our Foodbank Victoria sites: Altona, Ballarat, or Morwell.

Whether it's everyday emergencies or in times of crisis, Foodbank Victoria has been providing vital food relief to vulnerable Victorians for 95 years. We deliver food to people who need it in three different ways: in partnership with our charity partners, through schools and via our regional Community Food Centres.
