



How to register as a Foodbank WA partner agency

Hello, we're Foodbank WA

Foodbank WA supports registered charity partners that provide food assistance, including vouchers, hampers and pre-cooked meals, for everyday Western Australians who are struggling to put food on the table.

Register your charity with Foodbank WA and purchase low-cost groceries at any of our branches across WA. You will also be able to refer your clients to Foodbank WA, allowing them to shop with us directly.

Registering as a partner agency

Registration is valid for five years.

You will need:

- » Copy of your ACNC charity registration
- » Tick yes for an MOU if you wish to refer clients to shop directly at Foodbank WA

Referring clients to Foodbank WA

Once your registration is complete you will receive our referral form. Clients will need to show this referral on their first visit, along with ID to receive

their 6 month membership card allowing them to shop at any of our branches or Mobile Foodbank locations.

It is your responsibility to complete the referral form for each client. You assess each client for hardship and food insecurity through your existing assessment processes.

How you choose to determine hardship is up to you but we use the food insecurity definition that defines an individual as food insecure if they are without reliable access to a sufficient quantity of affordable, nutritious food AND only have less than 30% of their income left after all household bills are paid (e.g. rent, utilities, transport etc).

How it works

Our shop is like a supermarket, with aisles of food and groceries to choose from. You may not see the same variety as a supermarket, but we normally have the staples like pasta, rice, meat and fruit and vegetables. We mostly charge by weight rather than item.

- » **Perth Airport:** \$1.50/kg for grocery items and 20 cents/kg for bread and fresh milk. Fruit and vegetables are free.
- » **Regional branches:** \$1.50/kg for grocery items and 50 cents/kg for bread and fresh milk. Fruit and vegetables are free.

We also have frozen meals, meat packs and other bundles that are prices as marked. There is a 70kg maximum limit per week. Payment is by **EFTPOS ONLY**. We do not accept cash.

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Shopping at Foodbank WA

Mobile Foodbank

Mobile Foodbank is a great alternative for clients who find it difficult to travel to our branches. We offer hampers and individually priced items from our Mobile Foodbank:

- » Free Fruit/vegetable hampers
- » Individually priced frozen items
- » A range of everyday essential pantry items individually priced from \$1.50
