Group size and supervision ratio

We ask all schools to follow the group size and supervision ratio below to ensure a smooth and enjoyable experience for everyone.



Group size	Supervision ratio
30 students	One adult: 20 students Minimum of 2 staff per group

Please note that during the program, the group will be split into two for the warehouse tour and interactive activity. Make sure you have enough supervisors on hand to keep the fun going!

We encourage students to get inspired and create positive changes in their own communities.




Getting Here

Our School Tour Program is located
at our Altona warehouse:

🌻 **441-459 Kororoit Creek
Road, Altona 3018**

You'll find our warehouse nestled within an industrial complex, just past the roundabout of Grieves Parade and Kororoit Creek Road. Please note that Kororoit Creek Road is a one-way street. If driving from the Princes Highway Exit, you will need to make a U-turn at the roundabout.



Bus/Coach Parking Instructions

When you enter the complex, Foodbank Victoria is the first warehouse on the left! Students must be dropped off at the entry to the carpark. Please use the footpath to travel to reception. Student access is not permitted anywhere else.



Once the students have been dropped off, follow the path to the other side of our warehouse. Please press the intercom to notify our friendly logistics team of your arrival. They will help direct the bus to park.

Once the program has concluded, students will be picked up from the other side of reception.

Car Parking

Good news! There's free all-day parking onsite out the front of our reception. If you can't find a spot, don't worry – you can park in the overflow visitor carpark at the back of our warehouse. Please follow the footpath along the side of our warehouse to our entry.

Public Transport

If you're catching public transport, the closest bus station is 5km away on Millers Road. If you're walking, please note that Kororoit Creek Road is a busy road so please be mindful of traffic.

Accessibility

At Foodbank Victoria, we love creating a warm and welcoming environment for everyone! Our school tour program is designed to be single level, step-free, and accessibility-friendly. Plus, our warehouse has accessibility toilets on the ground floor to ensure everyone feels comfortable and included.

Arrival

Please enter through our reception!

When you arrive, we'll need you to sign into our warehouse and confirm the number of all students and adults attending onsite.



Start time

Please arrive at 11am. Your tour will run between 60-90 minutes. Running times are approximate and subject to change, so be ready for a flexible and fun experience!

Late arrivals

If you're running late, please call 03 9362 8300. Please note that late arrivals may result in a shortened experience.

Additional Details

What to wear

We recommend that all school staff, adults, and students wear enclosed shoes for safety. Don't worry, we'll provide you with a Hi-Viz vest when you arrive – you'll look great in it!



Storage

Got stuff? No problem! While we have limited storage available onsite, we suggest keeping any personal belongings in the vehicle you arrived in. That way, you can focus on having a fantastic time without worrying about your things.

Weather

No need to worry about the weather – our School Tour is indoors, so you'll stay dry and happy no matter the weather!

Need a spot for lunch?

You will find lots of petrol stations close to our warehouse, with some offering lunch. However, there are limited cafes within walking distance. We suggest going to Millers Junction which is a short drive away with lots of cafes and takeaway lunch options. Alternatively, we are 10-minute drive away from Altona Beach and pier. There are plenty of eateries and garden spaces available.
